# The OSSD CURRICULUM

The Ontario Secondary School Diploma curriculum is student-centered where students are taught knowledge and understanding, not just to sit exams, but to take what is learned and apply it, create with it and communicate through it. It is an innovative way of learning and our students not only enjoy it but are extremely well prepared for post-secondary programs at English speaking universities.

The Grades 9-12 years focus exclusively on the OSSD program. These levels run on a semester basis with an emphasis on project-based learning, assignments, experiential field trips, independent research and group work. # OSSD ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION

The Ontario Secondary School Diploma focuses on a cumulative system where the vital parts of a student's assessment and evaluation are based on course work throughout the semester. This is based on 70% continuous assessment and 30% final evaluation. This ensures that the students are always up-to-date with their academic responsibility, and teachers can easily monitor where students need to improve.

ELIT World also ensures that parent's receive progress reports both mid-term and at the end of each semester..

# ACADEMIC PATHWAYS

As the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) is an internationally recognized benchmark certificate, it is well accepted as an equivalent entrance testimonial to the GED (US) and GCSE (UK).

As it is a certificate from an English-speaking country, students are unlikely to require IELTS or TOEFL before entrance to international universities.



# The OSSD COURSE CONTENT



To complete the OSSD each student needs to successfully pass 30 credits over four years. Of those 30 credits, 18 are compulsory and 12 are optional. Before entering Grade 12, the student must have successfully completed Grades 9-11, passing all relevant courses. In addition to this all students must complete 40 community hours, working with a local community center, which is 10 hours for each Grade.



# OSSD COURSE CONTENT

## **GRADES 9-10 courses:**

The Grade 9-10 programs focus on building a strong academic foundation in a diverse area of studies. Each Grade program runs on a two-semester basis with every student registering for 8 courses (credits) throughout the year (4 credits per semester).

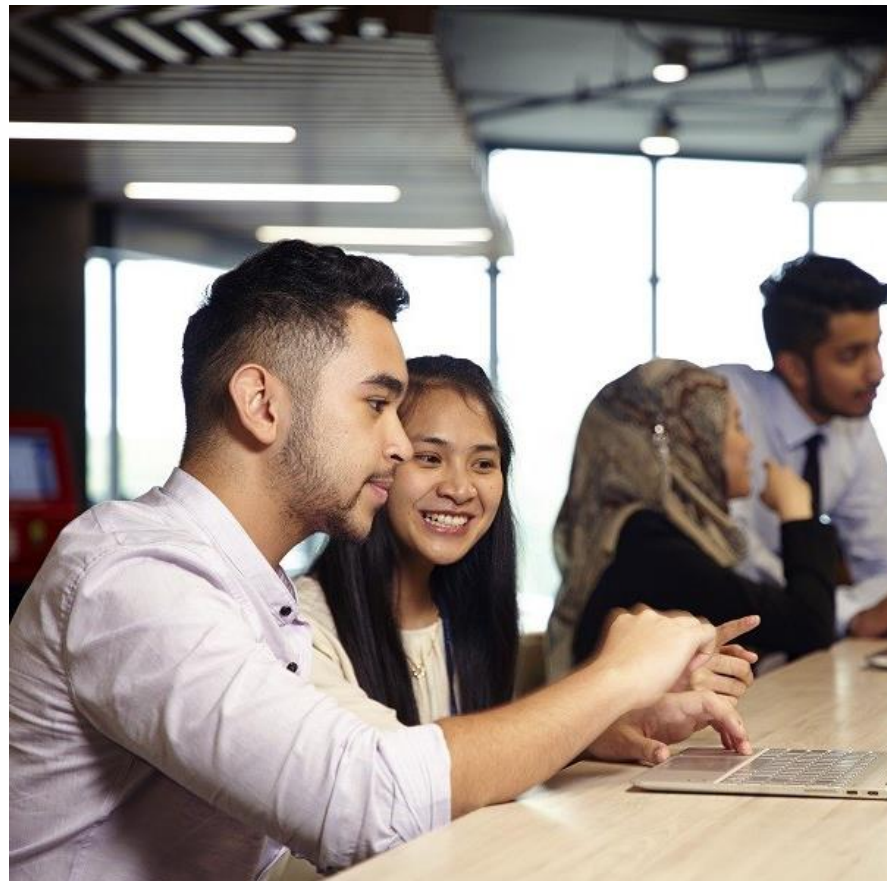

# OSSD COURSE CONTENT

## **GRADE 12 SUBJECTS:**

In the final year of the OSSD programme, students must have successfully completed all the Grades 9-11 courses. Due to the complexity of the Grade 12 course content, students are expected to select only 6 subjects for the full year (three per semester), and they must be in line with the subject pathway that students are planning to move to in their University course.

# ELIT WORLD FACILITIES AND SERVICES

All learning through ELIT World for the OSSD program is done online with state-of-the-art technology, and ongoing 24 hour technical support for all participating students from our friendly and highly experienced IT team.

Teachers from ELIT World will be using a well recognized conferencing platform to deliver the live courses using innovative and enjoyable approaches. As well as this the Ontario Ministry of Education Examiners will be engaging with all students and teachers on a regular basis in order that all courses are delivered and completed in line with the Ontario Ministry expectations and that they are also seen to be engaging and stimulating in the best way possible.

ELIT World also has a bank of online resources, from both the Ontario Ministry of Education as well as easily viewable recorded versions of all lessons in case students we unable to take part in any online activity on the day.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURES

The OSSD program Application process follows a simple 5 Step plan:

## **STEP 1: APPLICATION**

All applications must be submitted using the ELIT World application form together with the Application fee. The application fee can be made through either cash, bank transfer and/or online credit card payment.

## **STEP 2: DOCUMENTATION**

All application forms must be accompanied by the relevant items listed on the attached checklist.

All documentation will be reviewed, assessed and approved prior to the student taking the Readiness/Placement Assessment

# ADMISSION PROCEDURES

## **STEP 3: READINESS/PLACEMENT ASSESSMENT**

The Readiness/Placement Assessment is designed to determine the acceptance and grade placement for the applicant. The assessment will be conducted online by ELIT World upon confirmation of an appointment time. The Readiness/Placement Assessment test is a three hour comprehensive exam focusing on primarily Mathematics and English skills. The results take approximately 2 weeks to be reviewed and delivered back to the student.

The Readiness/Placement Assessment is only done upon the approval of the documentation in Step 3 and receipt of the Assessment fee.

After the assessment is completed the ELIT World Administration staff will be in touch with the candidate concerning the status of the application.



# ADMISSION PROCEDURES

## **STEP 4: REMAINING FEE PAYMENT**

Upon the student successfully completing Steps 1-3, they will be required to pay the remaining balance owing for the deposit and other fees before they can commence their course.

## **STEP 5: COMMENCEMENT OF COURSE**

Once all fees due are paid, the student will undergo a short orientation with our ELIT World Administration staff and will then be ready to begin their course.

# OTHER OSSD TESTS AND FEES

## **Grade 10-12 Literacy Test (OSSLT):**

Any students wishing to enter Grade 10-12 directly must do a mandatory Literacy Test prior to acceptance for the Grade 10-12 programme. Any student already completing Grade 9 through the ELIT World platform will be exempt from the test.

The Literacy Test requires **an additional fee of \$USD100 or RM420.**

## **What is the PLAR (PRIOR LEARNING ASSESSMENT AND RECOGNITION)?**

Upon completion of the Grade 12 OSSD programme, students wishing to move onto the University of their choice will undergo a PLAR which is a process that gives the opportunity to obtain academic credit for one or more courses in a certificate, diploma or degree.

The PLAR requires **an additional fee of \$USD460 or RM1920.**
